ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- A candidate who has passed any graduate degree program and has scored minimum 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA from a recognized university/institution is eligible to apply. However, a relaxation of 10% in marks shall be given in eligibility criteria to SC/ST/PWD candidates.
- The student should hold a degree from any of the universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India, or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a university under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- Those who are appearing in the final semester examination may also apply, provided that they submit the proof of eligibility and graduation marks at the time of personal interview.
- The student should hold a degree from any of the universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India, or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India.

In case the conversion formula for CGPA is not provided by the concerned Institute/ University, the equivalent percentage shall be computed as per the DTU/NSUT guidelines which are as follows:

$$\text{CGPA} \times 10 = \text{Percentage of Marks}$$

NOTE: At any stage of the program, if it is found that the candidate does not fulfil the eligibility criteria, his/ her admission shall be cancelled and the fee shall not be refunded.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Merit list for final admission shall be prepared on the basis of combined scores of the following components with weightages as given below:

- **Graduation marks (40%)**
- **Case Study (20%)**
- **Personal Interview (30%)**
- **Gender Diversity (5%)**
- **Academic Diversity (5%)**

NOTE: Candidate has to secure at least 40 percent marks of interview component to be considered eligible for admission. The University may invite fresh applications against vacant seats, if any, by following an alternative admission criterion, to be announced with a fresh call for admission to remaining seats.

NOTE: In case of tie in the final merit list, the following criteria shall be used:

- a) The candidate with higher graduation score will be ranked higher.
- b) In case of tie in the graduation score, the candidate shall be ranked according to the Personal Interview score; if tie persists, age in days will be used for selection.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

All candidates desirous of seeking admission to the MBA (IEV) programs at DTU, and NSUT are required to visit website www.dtu.ac.in/ www.nsut.ac.in/ www.cmacadmissions.com and fill registration form, pay a non-refundable registration fee and fill the choices for allotment of seat. Documents to be uploaded at the time of registration

Following is the list of documents required for uploading at the time of filling up of online application form:

- a) Degree and mark sheets of the qualifying examination or undertaking along with mark sheets till the previous semester.
- b) Certificates and Marks sheet of the 10th and 12th examination.
- c) Date of Birth Certificate as indicated in High School or equivalent examination i.e. Class X.
- d) Reserved category/sub-category certificates, if applicable.
- e) Recent passport size photograph
- f) Undertaking (if required)

NOTE: The OBC-NCL candidates can submit old certificate and undertaking at present in the application form. However, the candidates must submit the OBC-NCL or EWS certificates issued after March 2025 at the time of Personal Interview and Document Verification.

NOTE: If the candidate fails to produce any required documents, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.
