

# IGDTUW Incubation Centre "Anveshan Foundation – TBI"

Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women (IGDTUW) has incorporated and promoted 'IGDTUW Anveshan Foundation' a Section 8 Company under the Companies Act, 2013 to propagate entrepreneurial culture and ecosystem specially among women, on 13th October 2016. Government of NCT of Delhi has funded Rs. 2.14 crores in three tranches to support Anveshan Foundation i.e., for Innovation, Entrepreneurship, Start-ups and Incubation related activities at the University Campus.

Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India has sanctioned INR Four Crore Fifty Lakhs to accelerate the activities of Anveshan Foundation. Now, Anveshan is a Technical Business Incubator (TBI) under 'National Initiative for Development and Harnessing Innovations (NIDHI)' scheme of DST. First tranche of Rs. One Crore fifty-four lakhs has been received in the month of July 2021.

Anveshan has recently received a confirmation of Rs.8.57 Lakhs grant by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises for conducting a Women Acceleration Program in the last of 2022.

IGDTUW Anveshan Foundation has a pool of consultants and mentors associated with it to augment the businesses of its incubatees, which is an essential part of Acceleration.

Many of these incubatee companies are provided seed fund of up to INR 10 lakhs.

In addition to above fee structure, the following fee are also required to be paid at the time of admission:

- Security Deposit (Refundable):- ₹ 5,000/-
- One Time Alumni Fee:- ₹ 2,000/-
- Hostel and Mess fee, if applicable, will be paid separately.



#### **Minimum Eligibility for MBA Admissions:**

- 1. A female candidate who has passed any Bachelor Degree examination with minimum 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA from a recognized university/institution and valid CAT-2023 /MAT-2023 /MAT-2024 score. However, a relaxation of 10% in marks to SC/ST/PWD candidates and 5% to Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL) / Defense Category (CW) shall be given in minimum eligibility criteria.
- 2. The student should hold a degree from any of the universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India, or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a university under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- 3. Those who are appearing in final semester examination may also apply, provided that they submit.
- a. The proof of eligibility by a specific date declared by the University, and
- b. Valid CAT/MAT score at the time of application, otherwise the admission of the candidate to the university will be cancelled.
- 4. In case the conversion formula for CGPA is not provided by the concerned Institute/ University, equivalent percentage shall be computed as per the formula: CGPA  $\times$  10 = Percentage of Marks.

Note: At any stage of the program, if it is found that the candidate does not fulfill the eligibility criteria, his/ her admission shall be cancelled and fee shall not be refunded.

# Reservation Policy

- a. Scheduled Caste (SC): 15 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates.
- b. Scheduled Tribe (ST): 7.5 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates.
- **c. Other Backward Class (OBC- NCL)**: 27% of the total seats are reserved for Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy layer) candidates.
- **d. Economically Weaker Section (EWS):** 10% of the total seats are reserved for EWS category as per the office order DHE.1 (119)/Estt. /2018- 19/2549-76 dated 17/06/2019 Sub-categories namely 'Defence' and 'Person with Disability' are available under each category (General, SC, ST, OBC-NCL).
- **e. Defence (CW):** 5% of the total seats (Horizontal) in each main category are reserved for candidates belonging to Defence sub-category in the following order of priority:
- **Priority I** Widows/wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.
- **Priority II** Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service.
- **Priority III** Widows/wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.
- **Priority IV** Wards of disabled in service and boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service.
- **Priority V** Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel/para military/police personnel who are in receipt of the following Gallantry Awards: 1. Param Vir Chakra 2. Ashok Chakra 3. Mahavir Chakra 4. Kirti Chakra 5. Vir Chakra 6. Shaurya Chakra 7. Sena/Nau Sena/ Vayu Sena Medal 8. Mention-in-Despatches 9. President's Police Medal for Gallantry 10. Police Medal for Gallantry

**Priority VI** – Wards of Ex-servicemen.

**Priority VII** – Wives of:

- 1. Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service.
- 2. Defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.
- 3. Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry awards.

**Priority VIII** – Wards of serving personnel.

**Priority IX** – Wives of serving personnel.

**f. Person with Disability:** 5% of the total seats (Horizontally) in each category are reserved for candidates belonging to 'Person with Disability' sub-category in accordance with the provisions of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities

Act 2016' (PwD Act)

- **g. Kashmiri Migrants (Supernumerary):** 01 (One) seat, over and above the total intake is available under this category. First preference will be given to Kashmiri Migrant candidate:
- who has passed the qualifying examination from a school/college/ institute located within the NCT of Delhi;
- whose parents are registered in Delhi up to 11.06.2001 as Kashmiri Migrant; and
- who is residing in the N.C.T. of Delhi



#### Note:

- 1. In case of category (a) and (b), the vacant seats are interchangeable.
- 2. In case, sufficient numbers of eligible candidates from category (c) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved.
- 3. Seats under sub-category (f) are interchangeable within the sub category if sufficient number of candidates is not available in a particular group.
- 4. In case, sufficient number of eligible candidates from the sub categories mentioned at (e) and (f) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved in the respective category.
- 5. Under CW sub-category, the seats will be filled based on the priority, i.e. all eligible candidates of priority-I will be allotted seats based on their ranks until the ranks exhaust or seats exhaust under CW sub category. Remaining vacant seats, if any, will be allotted to the priority-II in the similar way, and so on. The reservation under CW sub category is available only to such candidates who fall under the listed priorities.
- 6. The reservation under CW sub category is available only to such candidates who fall under the listed priorities.
- 7. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories/sub categories. The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS/KM categories, CW/PwD sub-categories will be required to upload scanned copy of the respective certificates and produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority (as mentioned in this information brochure) in the respective institutes at the time of physical verification of the documents. If the reserved category/ sub-category certificate is not found in order, no benefit of the reserved category/ sub-category will be given and the candidate shall be considered for allotment in GENERAL category in subsequent rounds on submission of written request by the candidate to CMAC in person or email in this regard, as per the eligibility of the candidate and availability of seats. If such a candidate is able to produce her category certificate before the commencement of further round, she shall be considered for the category in that round and will be allotted a fresh seat as per the vacancy available and her merit.
- 8. After exhausting the complete list of registered SC, ST, OBC and EWS candidates, an equivalent number of unreserved seats shall be created against the vacant reserved category seats in the "SPOT ROUND".

# Selection Criterion

- 1. The applications received will be shortlisted based on performance in CAT-2023/ MAT-2023/ MAT-2024.
- 2. The shortlisted candidates will be required to appear for a Personal Interview and document verification. The Candidates who do not participate in Personal Interview/Document Verification will not be considered in the Merit List.
- 3. The merit list will first consider the candidates with valid CAT 2023 percentile and after the CAT 2023 candidates are exhausted, the candidates with MAT 2023/ 2024 percentile will be considered in the merit list. In case any candidate has appeared in both MAT 2023 and MAT 2024 Best of Two will be taken in consideration. The CAT or MAT percentile will be rounded upto two decimal places for calculating the Weightage.
- 4. The Merit list will be prepared considering the following components:

### Certificates Required for Reserved Seats at the Time of Document Verification

The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS categories, CW/PwD subcategories will be required to produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority at the time of document verification.

#### Persons with Disabilities (PD) sub-category

For admission to seat reserved for Differently Abled Person (PwD) sub-category, the candidate must produce the following certificates in original at the time of document verification for PwD candidates.

- A certificate of physical disability issued by the Competent Authority as per the provision of the Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 in the prescribed format as given under the Act.
- 2. The Candidate with benchmark disabilities shall produce the medical certificate issued by the Govt. Hospitals duly notified by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi/Other State government and further duly verified by the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned Government Hospital.
- 3. A certificate duly recommended by Vocational Rehabilitation Centre for the handicapped, 9-11 Vikas Marg, Karkardooma, Delhi 110092.

# Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Class (OBC)

For admission to a seat reserved for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class - Non Creamy Layer (OBC - NCL), candidates must produce a certificate, in original, issued from an approved district authority stating the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), to which the candidate belongs.

#### A list of approved authorities is given below:

- District Magistrate / Additional Magistrate / Deputy Commissioner / Collector / Additional Deputy Commissioner / Deputy Collector / 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate /City (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate), Sub-Divisional Magistrate /Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- 2. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- 3. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidates and/or his/her family normally resides.
- 4. Administrator/Secretary to Administration/Development Officer (Laccadive & Minicoy Islands).

#### **Economically Weaker Section: Criteria for Income and Assets**

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed by persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority based upon the following criteria:

Candidates whose family has gross annual income below Rs 8.0 lakh (Rupees eight lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-

- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iv. Residential, plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and

Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority after March 31, 2024. The Income and Asset Certificate issued 'by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in Annexures shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as 'belonging to EWS.

#### A list of approved authorities is given below:

- District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/ Additional' Deputy Commissioner/Ist Class Stipendary Magistrate/Sub Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner
- 2. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate
- 3. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and
- 4. Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or her family normally resides

#### **Defence sub-category (CW)**

For admission to a seat reserved for Defence sub-category, candidate must produce the following certificates (as applicable), in original, at the time of document verification of Defence candidates.

- 1. Entitlement card in original issued by the Record Officer of the Unit/Regiment of Armed Personnel of the Armed Forces in case of Armed Personnel.
- 2. Widows/ Wards/ Wives of the officers and men of Armed forces who died or were disabled on duty (both attributable to military service) must produce a certificate to that effect from the following authorities:
- 2.1. Secretary, Kendriya Sainik Board.
- 2.2. Secretary, Rajya / Zila Sainik Board.
- 2.3. Officer-in-Charge, Record Office.
- 2.4. Medical records in original.
- 2.5. Special Pension Order and Passbook indicating special pension.
- 2.6. Gallantry Award Certificate.
- 2.7. Original ex-servicemen Identity Card/Discharge Book/ Pension Payment Order.
- 2.8. Original Service Identity Card.
- 2.9. A certificate from the respective C.O. Unit in respect of serving personnel.

#### NOTE:

A statement to the effect that 'the death/disability is attributed to military service' is required to be included in the certificate for Priority III & IV.

THE FINAL PRIORITY WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE SCRUTINY BY PANEL OF DEFENCE EXPERTS AT THE TIME OF DOCUMENT VERIFICATION.

#### **Kashmiri Migrants:**

- 1. The candidates seeking admission under Kashmiri Migrants seats must upload the following documents at the time of filling up of the online application.
- 2. Certificate of registration as Kashmiri Migrants issued by the Relief Commissioner, Jammu or Divisional Commissioner, Delhi to establish the status of the applicant as registered migrants.
- 3. Degree and Mark-sheet of the qualifying examination.
- 4. Secondary School Examination or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto (showing the Date of Birth).
- 5. Proof of property in Kashmir of the parent of the candidate.
- 6. Proof of current residence such as Ration Card, Photo Identity Card issued by the Election Commissioner, Driving License, etc.

#### **Personal Interview and Document Verification**

The shortlisted candidates will be called for Personal Interview and Document verification in physical mode. The venue and date for the same will be announced on www. cmacadmission.com/. The merit list of the eligible candidates will be announced on CMAC website before First round of Counselling.

NOTE: The candidates, who do not attend the Personal Interview and document verification process, will not be considered in the merit list.

#### **Counselling and Payment of Seat Acceptance Fee:**

The candidates will be called for Admission Counselling as per their rank in the merit list. A candidate, who is allotted a seat in any round of counselling is required to pay the part admission fee of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh only) as per the payment mode instructed in the guidelines of counselling.

All the candidates who get an allotment will have to pay part admission fee (Rs.1,00,000 – Rupees One Lakh) as per the admission schedule, failing which her allotted seat will stand automatically cancelled and the candidate will not be considered for subsequent rounds of seat allotment. However, such candidates are eligible for spot round of counselling. Balance fees need to be paid by the candidate in the respective University at the time of academic registration.

Note: If the candidate is allotted a seat in a round and she does not pay the required academic fee as per counseling schedule, her allotted seat shall be cancelled and he/she will not be considered for any seat allotment in subsequent rounds (except spot round).

#### **Up-Gradation**

After each round of counselling, the candidates who wish to change the University allotted to her will be given choice to upgrade to the University of his/her preference subject to the rank of candidate and availability of the seat.

#### **Spot-Round**

Spot round may be conducted if seats remain vacant. Details of the spot round will be notified on the website www.cmacadmissions.com.

Fresh applications against vacant seats, if any, may be invited and CMAC may follow alternate admission criteria for admissions in spot round such as CUET (PG) Socre.

\*Special spot round may be conducted by the respective University separately after the spot round depending upon the availability of vacant seats.



# Reporting to the Finally Allotted University

All provisionally admitted candidates are required to visit the website of allotted university for physical verification of original documents/commencement of classes and payment of balance fee (if any). Admitted candidates need to pay the balance fee at the final allotted University AS PER FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE available on respective university website, failing which, the admission of the candidate automatically stands cancelled ipso facto.

#### **Withdrawal Policy:**

The University follows the following policy for the remittance and refund of fee, if a student chooses to withdraw from programme in which she in enrolled:

All fee refunds of the candidates, who have withdrawn their till the date of spot round, will be made by CMAC, Delhi 2024 as per the withdrawal policy of the respective University from where withdrawal is taken. After the date of spot round, the candidates have to approach the respective allotted Universities for any withdrawals.
