Supported by the Government of NCT of Delhi and the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India, Anveshan serves as a Host Institute under the DC-MSME's innovative scheme, empowering women-led startups through structured incubation and funding support.

Anveshan is helping entrepreneurs and start-ups in:

Pre-incubation, Incubation, Acceleration, Post-incubation, and Virtual Incubation.

In the pre-incubation phase, budding entrepreneurs receive training in idea validation, PoC, prototyping, IPR, pitching, business planning, and presentation skills. A dynamic Entrepreneurship Cell (E-Cell), run by students, promotes peer-led innovation on campus.

Anveshan has successfully supported 51 women-led startups, providing infrastructure, seed funding (up to ₹20 lakhs), business consultancy, and incorporation assistance. Startups benefit from a fully equipped, air-conditioned office space with ICT support and mentoring in technical, strategic, and business domains.

In collaboration with CISCO and NASSCOM Foundation, Anveshan hosts the thingQbator IoT & Robotics Lab, a ₹60 lakh CSR initiative that has benefited over 300 students through four innovation cohorts. Structure of BBA Program

The BBA courses are divided into four distinct areas, namely:



Nomenclature

Departmental Core Courses (DCC)

These are department specific compulsory courses to be studied by the student as a core requirement for the BBA degree. These courses also include "Summer Project Report and Viva Voice" and "Major Project Report and Viva Voice".

Allied Management Course (AMC)

These compulsory courses are allied/vocational/value added/skill oriented/ability enhancement The purpose of these courses is to develop various skills required in management and business environment such as computer applications, mathematical, statistical, ICT knowledge, technical report writing, and business communication skills.

Departmental Elective Courses (DEC)

These courses are specific or advanced or supportive to the discipline/subject/specialization of study or which provides an extended scope. Management Department would offer a wide range of elective courses pertaining to the concerned BBA degree.


Generic Open Elective Courses (GEC)



Eligibility Criteria

A Female candidate who has scored at least 50% marks in 12th board examination from a recognised board and must also have passed English (Core/Elective/Functional) as a subject in the 12th Board Examination.



Relaxation in Minimum Marks Criterion in Qualifying Examination for Reserved Category/Sub-Category Candidates

Candidates belonging to various reserved categories namely OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, and sub-categories namely Defence, Person with Disability, who apply for seats reserved for them, shall be allowed a relaxation in the minimum marks criterion as mentioned below:

- (i) Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL): Candidates claiming reservation under Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) category shall be allowed a relaxation of 5% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- (ii) Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST): Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST) shall be allowed a relaxation of 10% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- (iii) Defence (CW): Candidates claiming reservation under Defence subcategory (CW) shall be allowed a relaxation of 5% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- (iv) Persons with Disabilities (PwD): Candidates claiming reservation under "Persons with Disabilities" (PwD) sub-category shall be allowed a relaxation of 10% marks.

Intake

The annual intake of this program is 75+1*. The reservation of the seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS and sub categories Defence/PwD are as per the norms. One seat is for Kashmiri Migrant over and above the total intake. However, there will be no relaxation in the minimum eligibility criteria for Kashmiri Migrant.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- a) The admissions in BBA program will be based on score of CUET -UG 2025. Seat allotment will be done strictly on the basis of the merit of the candidate, priority/choice of the institution/university filled by the candidate and availability of seats in the respective category of the candidate as per rules.
- b) The merit list will be prepared on the basis of score of CUET UG 2025 in the following two components:

English (Code 101) and General Aptitude Test(Code 501)

c) The weightage of the above components in preparation of the Merit list will be as follows:

S. No.	Weightage
1. Score in English (Code 101)	25%
2. Score in General Aptitude Test (Code 501)	75%

In case of tie in the final merit list, the following criteria shall be used:

- i) The candidate with higher score in General Aptitude Test shall be ranked higher.
- ii) In case of tie in score in General Aptitude Test, the candidate older in age will be ranked higher.
- iii) In case of tie in the age criterion, the candidate with higher score in English (Class XII) shall be ranked higher.
- iv) In case of tie in English (Class XII), random number will be used to break the tie.

Note: - If the Candidate has not appeared in the tests of English (Code 101) and General Test (Code 501) in CUET UG 2025, such candidate will not be considered in the merit List and such candidates need not to apply for BBA admissions through CMAC 2025.

Counselling and Payment of Seat Acceptance Fee

Seat allotment will be done strictly on the basis of the merit of the candidate, priority/choice of the institution/university filled by the candidate and availability of seats in the respective category of the candidate as per rules. The allotment of seats, Documents Verification Schedule and Part admission fee payment schedule (Rs. 1,00,000) will be notified on CMAC website. If the candidate does not appear for documents verification, his/her seat will automatically get cancelled.

A candidate, who is allotted a seat in any round of counselling is required to pay the part admission fee of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh only) as per the payment mode instructed in the guidelines of counseling (The detailed guidelines will be issued in due course of time on CMAC-2025 website). Balance fees need to be paid by the candidate in the University at the time of academic registration.

All the candidates who get an allotment will have to pay part admission fee (Rs.1,00,000/–Rupees One Lakh) as per the admission schedule, failing which his/her allotted seat will stand automatically cancelled and the candidate will not be considered for subsequent rounds of seat allotment. However, such candidates are eligible for spot round of counselling.

Upgradation

After each round of counselling, the admitted candidates will be given chance to upgrade to the University as per the rank of the candidate, choice/priority of the candidate filled in application form and availability of seats in the respective category of the candidate as per rules. Candidates are advised to fill the choices carefully.

Spot round

Spot round may be conducted if seats remain vacant. Details of spot round will be notified on the website www.cmacadmissions.com.

NOTE: Fresh applications against vacant seats, if any, may be invited by following an alternative admission criterion in spot round of admissions by CMAC.

*Special spot round may be conducted by the respective University separately after the spot round depending upon the availability of vacant seats.

d). Reporting at final allotted university

All provisionally admitted candidates are required to visit the website of the university for physical verification of original documents/commencement of classes and payment of balance fee (if any). Admitted candidates need to pay the balance fee at the final allotted University AS PER FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE of respective university, failing which, the admission of the candidate automatically stands cancelled ipso facto.



Reservation Policy

Delhi Region

Delhi Region Candidates (85% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located within the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Delhi Region only.

Outside Delhi

Outside Delhi Region Candidates (15% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located outside the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Outside Delhi Region only.

NOTE: For a candidate, who has passed the qualifying examination through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School, Delhi (NIOS), the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of her centre of examination. In other words, if the centre of examination is located in the N.C.T. of Delhi, the candidate shall be considered under the Delhi Region and if the centre of examination is located outside N.C.T. of Delhi, she shall be considered under the Outside Delhi Region.

- a. Scheduled Caste (SC): 15 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates.
- b. Scheduled Tribe (ST): 7.5 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates.
- c. Other Backward Class (OBC- NCL): 27% of the total seats are reserved for Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates.
- d. Economically Weaker Section (EWS): 10% of the total seats are reserved for EWS category as per the office order DHE.1 (119)/Estt. /2018- 19/2549-76 dated 17/06/2019 Sub-categories namely 'Defence' and 'Person with Disability' are available under each category (General, SC, ST, OBC-NCL).
- e. Defence (CW): 5% of the total seats (Horizontal) in each main category are reserved for candidates belonging to Defence sub-category in the following order of priority:

Priority I - Widows/wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.

Priority II - Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service.

Priority III - Widows/wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.

Priority I - Widows/wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.

Priority II – Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service.

- **Priority III** Widows/wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.
- **Priority IV** Wards of disabled in service and boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service.
- **Priority V** Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel/para military/police personnel who are in receipt of the following Gallantry Awards: 1. Param Vir Chakra 2. Ashok Chakra 3. Mahavir Chakra 4. Kirti Chakra 5. Vir Chakra 6. Shaurya Chakra 7. Sena/Nau Sena/ Vayu Sena Medal 8. Mention-in-Despatches 9. President's Police Medal for Gallantry 10. Police Medal for Gallantry

Priority VI - Wards of Ex-servicemen.

Priority VII - Wives of:

- 1. Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service
- 2. Defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service
- 3. Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry awards.


Priority VIII - Wards of serving personnel.

Priority IX - Wives of serving personnel.

- f) Person with Disability: 5% of the total seats (Horizontally) in each category are reserved for candidates belonging to 'Person with Disability' sub-category in accordance with the provisions of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016' (PwD Act).
- **g) Kashmiri Migrants (Supernumerary):** 01 (One) seat, over and above the total intake is available under this category. First preference will be given to Kashmiri Migrant candidate:
 - i.who has passed the qualifying examination from a school/college/institute located within the NCT of Delhi;
 - ii. whose parents are registered in Delhi up to 11.06.2001 as Kashmiri Migrant; and
- iii. who is residing in the N.C.T. of Delhi.

Note:

- i. In case of category (a) and (b), the vacant seats are interchangeable.
- ii. In case, sufficient numbers of eligible candidates from category (c) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved.
- iii. Seats under sub-category (f) are interchangeable within the sub category if sufficient number of candidates is not available in a particular group.
- iv. In case, sufficient number of eligible candidates from the sub categories mentioned at (e) and (f) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved in the respective category.
- v. Under CW sub-category, the seats will be filled based on the priority, i.e., all eligible candidates of priority-I will be allotted seats based on their ranks until the ranks exhaust or seats exhaust under CW sub category. Remaining vacant seats, if any, will be allotted to the priority-II in the similar way, and so on.
- vi. The reservation under CW sub category is available only to such candidates who fall under the listed priorities.
- vii. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories/sub categories. The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS/KM categories, CW/PwD sub-categories will be required to upload scanned copy of the respective certificates and produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority (as mentioned in this information brochure) in the respective institutes at the time of physical verification of the documents. If the reserved category/ sub-category certificate is not found in order, no benefit of the reserved category/ sub-category will be given and the candidate shall be considered for allotment in GENERAL category in subsequent rounds on submission of written request by the candidate to CMAC in person or email in this regard, as per the eligibility of the candidate and availability of seats. If such a candidate is able to produce her category certificate before the commencement of further round, she shall be considered for the category in that round and will be allotted a fresh seat as per the vacancy available and her merit.
- viii) After exhausting the complete list of registered SC, ST, OBC and EWS candidates, an equivalent number of unreserved seats shall be created against the vacant reserved category seats in the "SPOT ROUND".



Withdrawal /Refund Policy For BBA Admissions 2025

Certificates required for claiming Reserved Seats

Candidates applying for any reserved seat (i.e., EWS, SC, ST, OBC-NCL, CW, PD, KM) must upload the scanned copy of the certificates (as applicable) as mentioned below at the time filling up of the ONLINE application form.

Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL)

For admission to a seat reserved for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), candidate must produce a certificate, in original, issued from an approved district authority stating the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), to which the candidate belongs. A list of approved authorities is given below:

- District Magistrate/Additional Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner/ Collector/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/Ist Class Stipendiary Magistrate / City Magistrate (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate), Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidates and/or his/her family normally resides.
- Administrator/SecretarytoAdministration/DevelopmentOfficer(Laccadive&Minicoy Islands).

NOTE:

- 1. The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories has to mandatorily upload the caste/ category certificate in his/her name at the time of filling up of the ONLINE form. The certificate in the name of either of the parents (mother/father) or any other family member is not acceptable and the candidate will not be entitled even for provisional admission.
- 2. The reservation certificate should be issued from the respective state/region in which the reservation is being claimed, e.g., in case, a candidate claims the seat reserved for the Delhi Region category, she has to bring SC/ST/OBC certificate issued by Govt. of NCT of Delhi and should have also passed her qualifying examination from a School / College / Institute located in National Capital Territory of Delhi.
- 3. OBC (NCL) candidates are required to produce a caste certificate issued after March 31, 2025 from the authorities as mentioned above. However, if the certificate is issued prior to March 31, 2025, it must be accompanied with an additional certificate regarding the present non-creamy layer status of the candidate, issued by the same competent authority valid for the year 2025-26. This additional certificate must have reference of his/her already issued original caste certificate.
- 4. Students claiming OBC reservation under Delhi region will be admitted in this category on the submission of a certificate to this effect from the Competent Authority of the Government of NCT of Delhi. Certificate issued by Govt. of India or any state government will not be accepted under any circumstances. A certificate issued by a Competent Authority of Delhi to an individual on the basis of Caste Certificate of her parents from another state will be accepted for claiming a seat under OBC Category IF AND ONLY IF the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

Defence sub - category (CW)

For admission to a seat reserved for Defence sub-category, candidate must produce the following certificates (as applicable), in original, at the time of document verification of Defence candidates:

- a. Entitlement card in original issued by the Record Officer of the Unit/Regiment of Armed Personnel of the Armed Forces in case of Armed Personnel.
- b. Widows/ Wards/ Wives of the officers and men of Armed forces who died or were disabled on duty (both attributable to military service) must produce a certificate to that effect from the following authorities:
- i. Secretary, KendriyaSainik Board.
- ii. Secretary, Rajya / Zila Sainik Board.
- iii. Officer-in-Charge, Record Office.
- c. Medical records in original.
- d. Special Pension Order and Passbook indicating special pension.
- e. Gallantry Award Certificate.
- f. Original ex-servicemen Identity Card/Discharge Book/ Pension Payment Order.
- g. Dependency card issued by the competent authority in order to relate the relationship of the candidate with the Defence personnel.
- h. Original Service Identity Card.
- i. A certificate from the respective C.O. Unit in respect of serving personnel.

NOTE:

A statement to the effect that 'the death/disability is attributed to military service' is required to be included in the certificate for Priority III & IV.

Person with Disability sub-category

For admission to seat reserved for person with disabilities (PwD) sub-category, the candidate must upload the following certificates at the time of filling up the Online form:

a. Certificate of physical disability issued by the Competent Authority as per the provisions of the Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 in the prescribed format as given under the Act. b. The candidate with benchmark disabilities shall produce the medical certificate issued by the Govt. Hospitals duly notified by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi/ other State government and further duly verified by the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned Government Hospital. c. A certificate duly recommended by Vocational Rehabilitation Centre for the handicapped, 9-11 Vikas Marg, Karkardooma, Delhi 110092.

Kashmiri Migrants

The candidates seeking admission under Kashmiri Migrants seats must upload the following documents at the time of filling up of the online application:

- a. Certificate of registration as Kashmiri Migrants issued by the Relief Commissioner, Jammu or Divisional Commissioner, Delhi to establish the status of the applicant as registered migrants. Such a certificate should be issued by the concerned Deputy Commissioner of Delhi or the Competent Authority outside Delhi.
- b. Provisional or original Senior School Certificate examination or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto.
- c. Mark-sheet of the Senior School Certificate Examination or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto.
- d. Secondary School Examination or an examination recognized as equivalent there to (showing the Date of Birth).
- e. Proof of property in Kashmir of the parent of the candidate.
- f. Proof of current residence such as Ration Card, Photo Identity Card issued by the Election Commissioner, Driving License, etc


